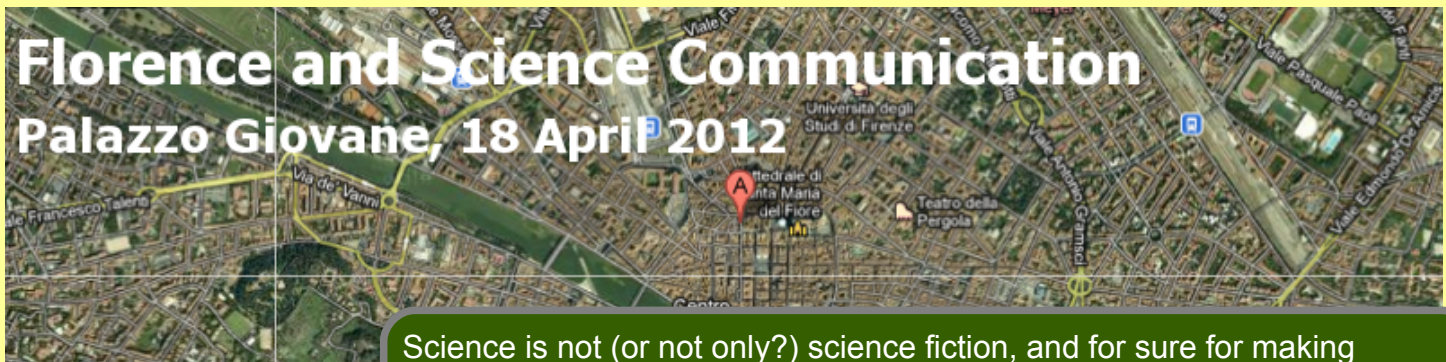


Florence and Science Communication
